Search for a Tack Equipment

Step 1: When you open the FEI TackApp, you will land on the main page where you can see the different categories (**Artificial Aids, Bits, Body Accessories**, etc...).

Scroll down to see all the categories available on the main page. Click on **See all** to see all the equipment of the relevant category.

Step 2: You can use the filters available at the top to filter for the Tack Equipment you are looking for.

Select the relevant filter, for example **Category** and select one of the categories available (**Artificial Aids**, **Bits**, **Body Accessories**, etc...). Scroll down to see more categories.

Step 3: Once you have chosen a **Category**, you can filter by a **Sub-Category** of the **Category** you have first selected.

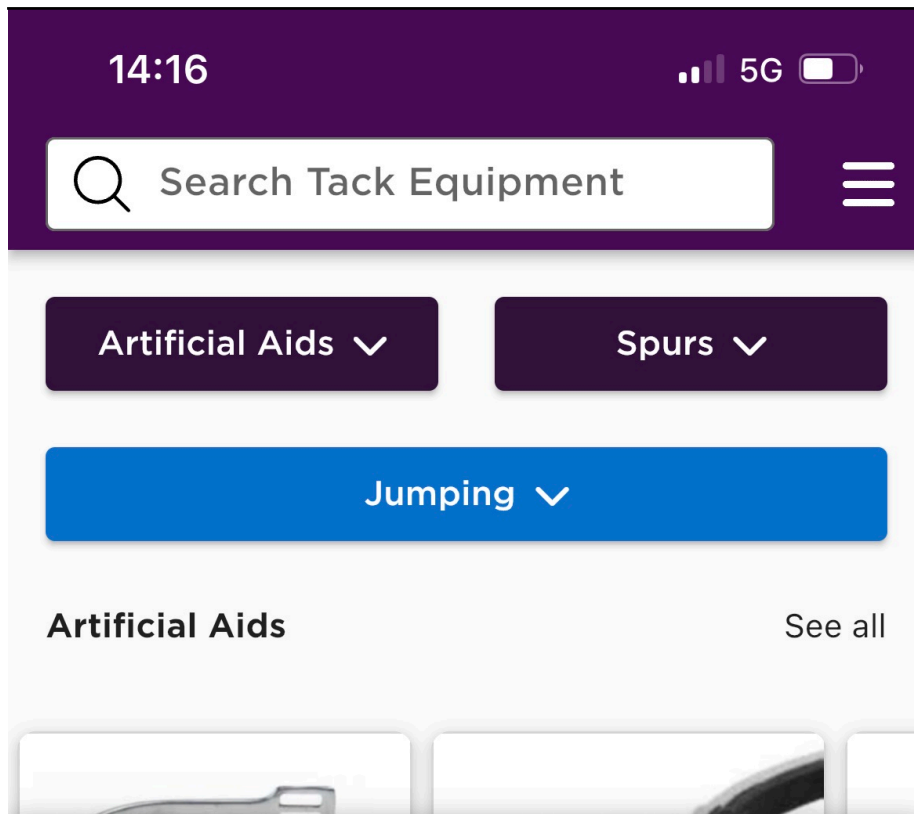

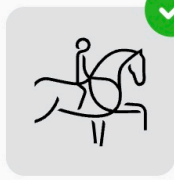

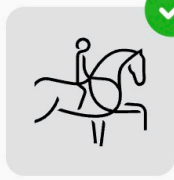

With the exception of CSI(O)P and CSI(O)Ch, there are no restrictions on bridles and nosebands. However, the Ground Jury has the right, based on veterinary advice, to forbid the use of a noseband that may cause injury to the Horse.

The information is arranged by discipline, category and subcategory of tack and equipment. Each individual piece of tack and equipment is represented using photographs, illustrations and/or videos; is accompanied with the relevant legal basis and is clearly marked as allowed or prohibited. If special conditions apply, it will be marked using an exclamation mark (!). Please kindly note that the designation "Not Applicable" or "N/A" means that the relevant tack, equipment or dress is either not relevant for the specific Discipline, is currently not addressed or specified in the Discipline Rule or has not yet been addressed by the FEI.

Please be aware that the information provided in the Database is non-exhaustive and that new tack, equipment and dress is added to the Database on a regular basis.
