FEI Entry System for Jumping How to transfer a Horse from one Event to another in the FEI Entry System

One of your Athletes' Horses is not entered in the correct Event?

You need to change a Horse from one Event category to another?

It is now possible to transfer an entry from one Event to another of the same Show, without withdrawing and re-entering the combination.

Step 1: Connect to the new version of the <u>FEI Entry System</u> and find the Show in which you wish to change the Horse's entry.

Step 2: Find the Horse you wish to transfer from one Event to another and click on **Horse - Transfer**:

Step 3.2: If you wish to transfer the Horse to an **Invitation System Event,** you will have to select the quota in which you wish to transfer the entry.

- You can select **Home NF quota** if the Show is held in your own Country AND if the **Home NF quota** is not full or the period has not expired
- You can select **OC quota** if you wish for the entry to be considered by the Organising Committee
- If the Event is not in your own Country, the **OC quota** is selected by default
