How to upload a PCR test on the FEI HorseApp

You need to provide a negative PCR test for EHV-1 prior to a FEI Event?

Step 1: To provide the FEI with a copy of your negative PCR test, you must download and use the FEI HorseApp.

Step 3: You can expand the Horse information to check you are on the correct Horse. Open the **Horse Health** menu and click on **EHV-1 PCR Test**.

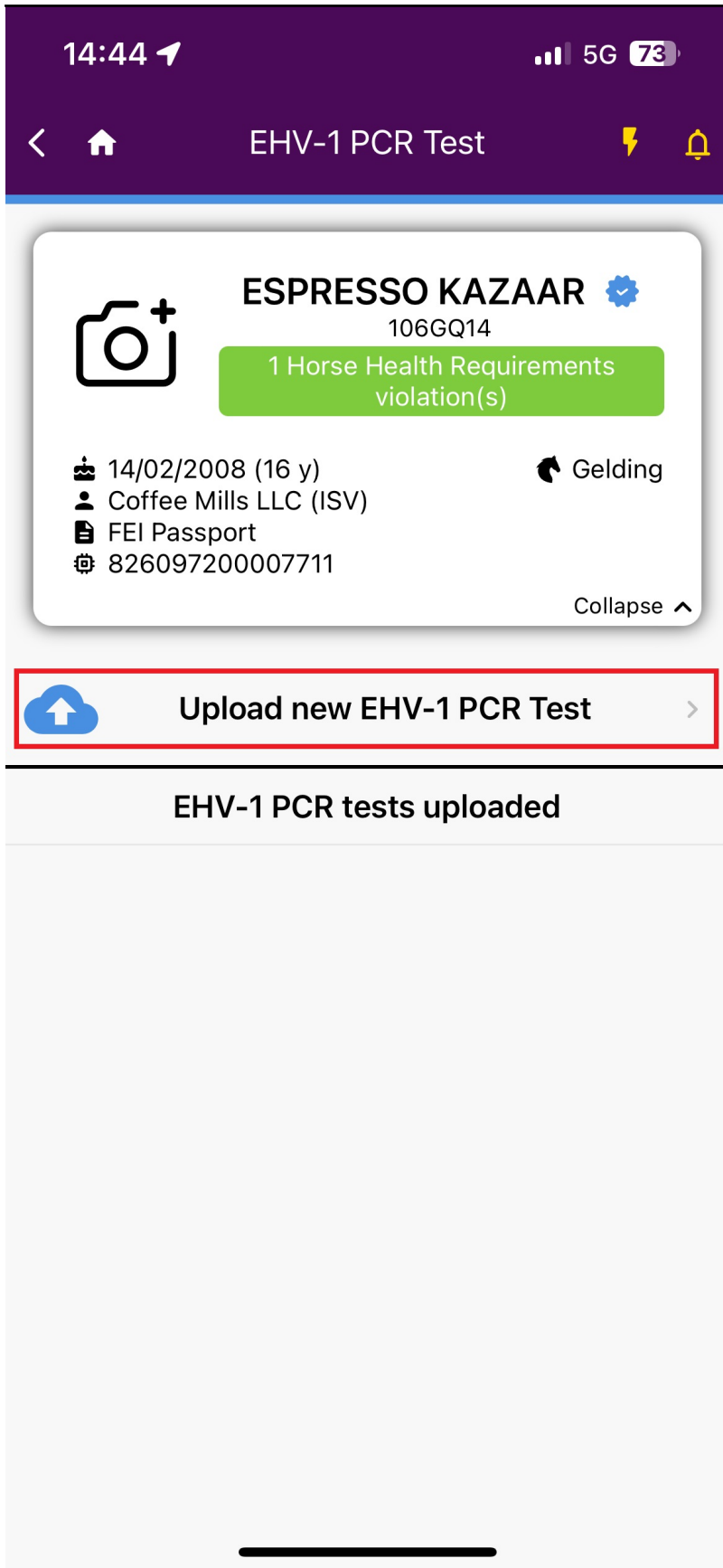

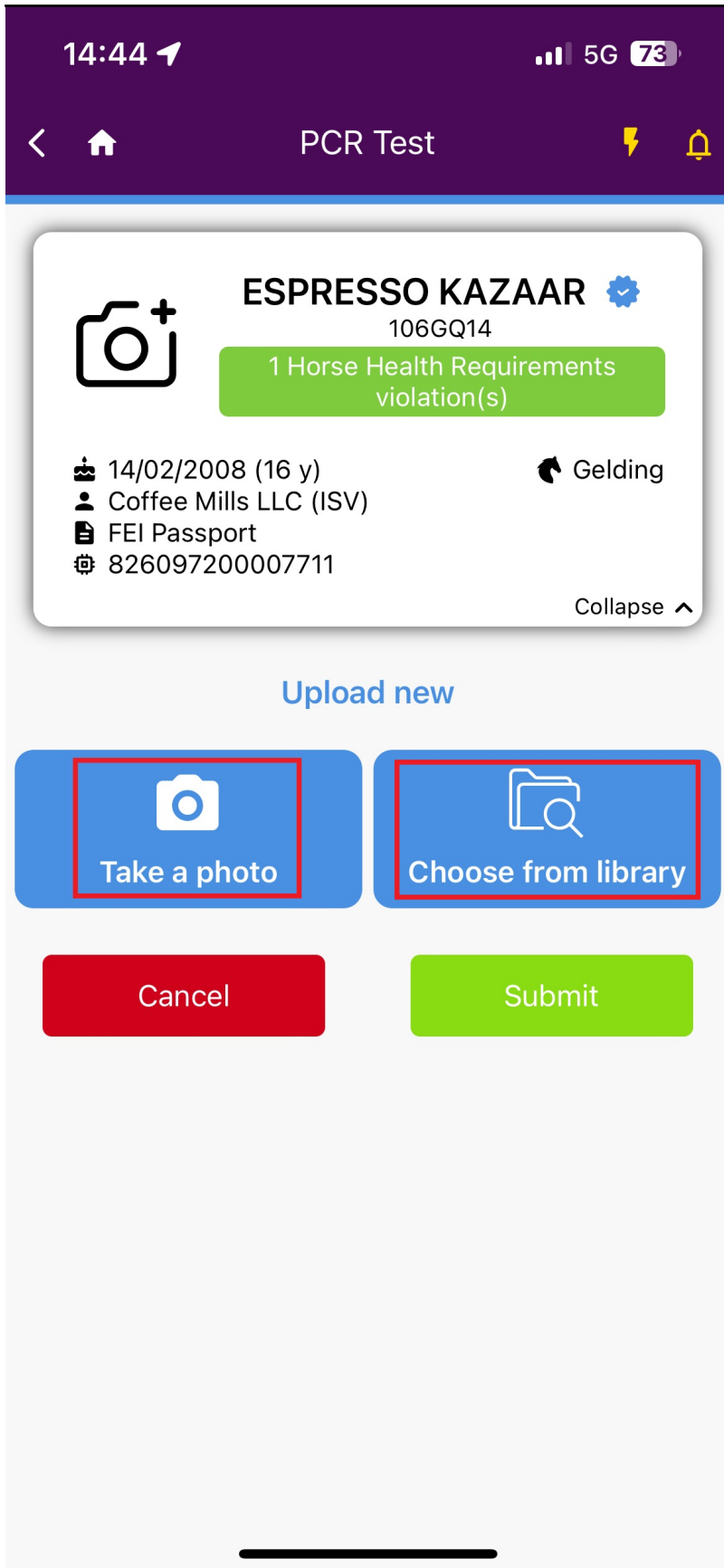

The application will walk you through the necessary steps.

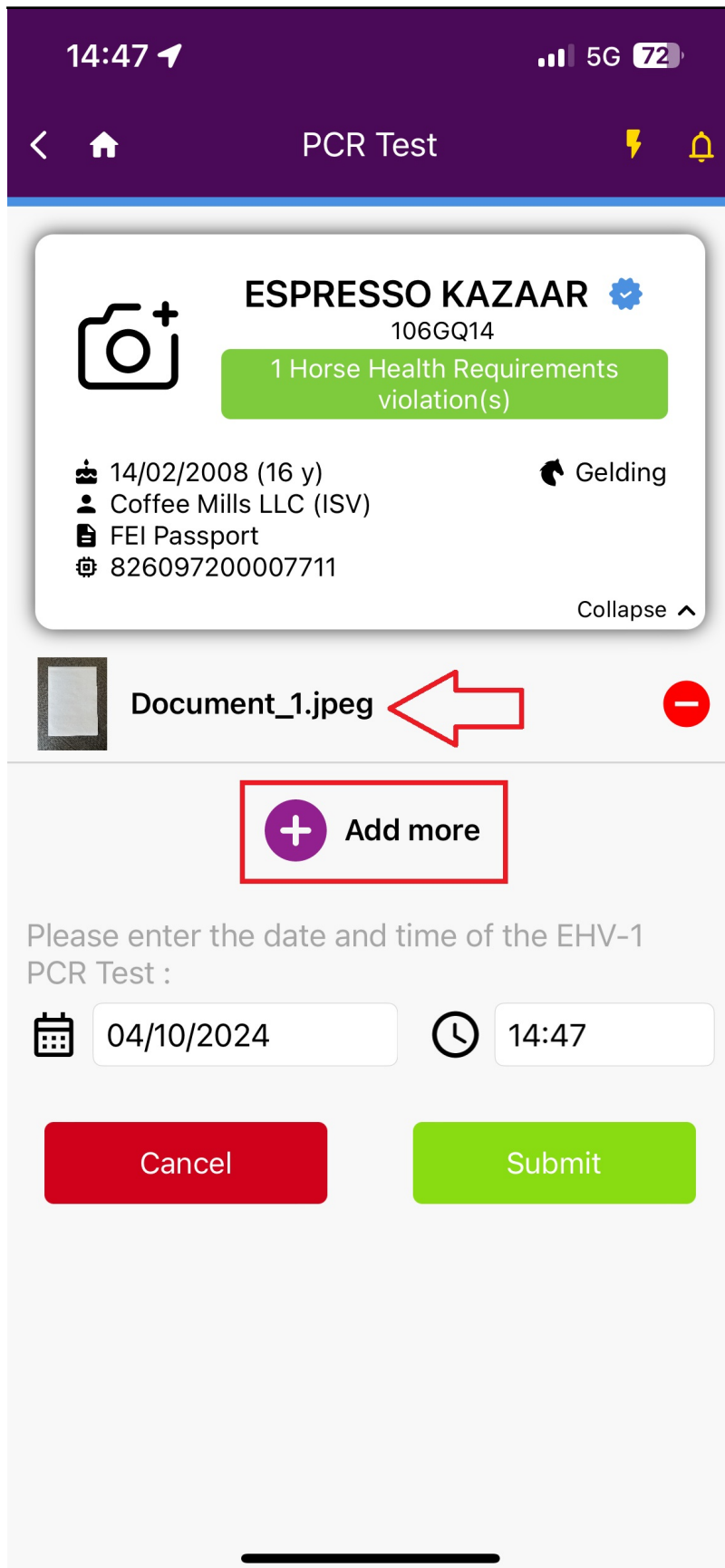

If you need to add further documents, click on **Add more** to upload further photos.



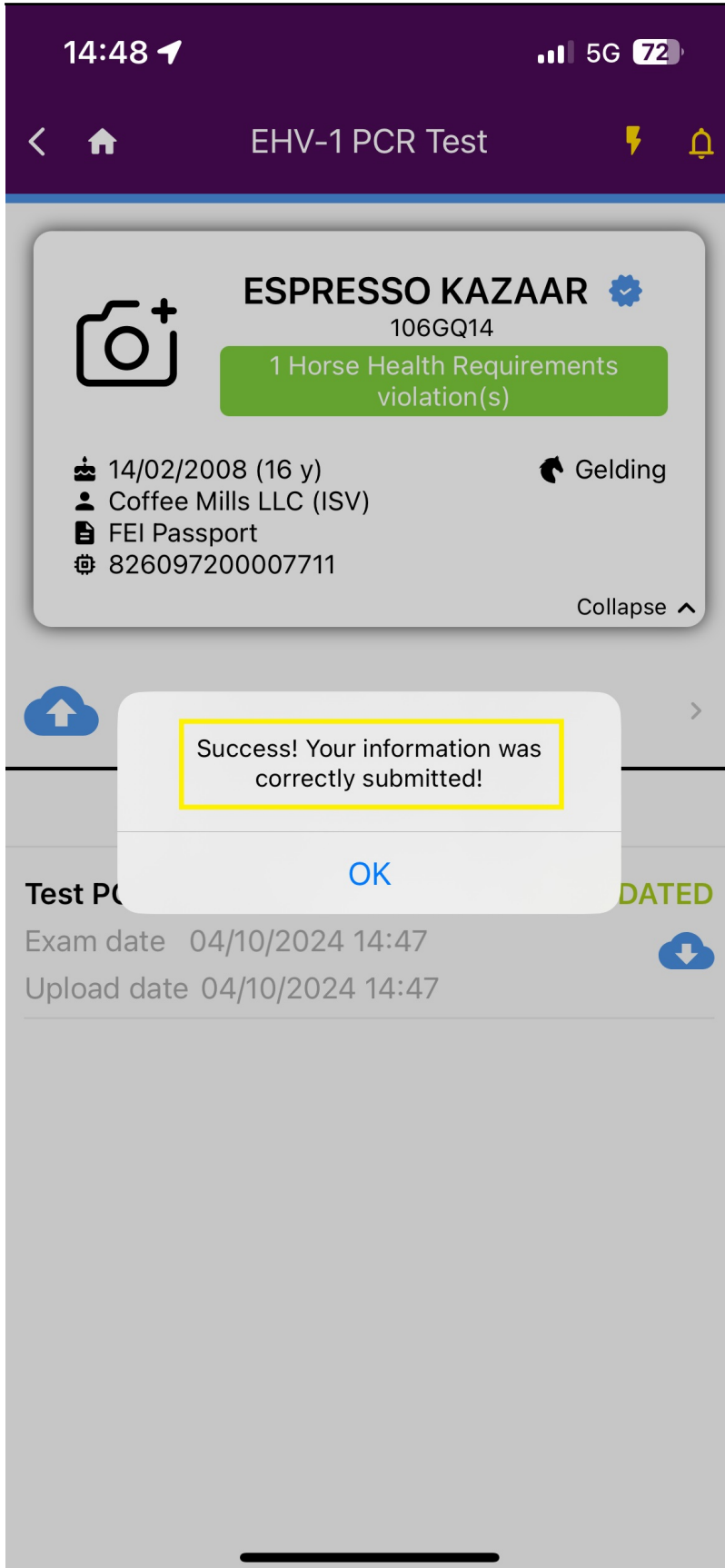

Step 6: You must enter the **date** and **time** when the PCR sample/test was taken and then click on **Submit**.
