You cannot submit your schedule to your National Federation because certain sections have not been acknowledged?


**Step 1:** Connect to the FEI Online Schedule Platform (<u>https://schedules.fei.org</u>) with your FEI credentials.

Step 2: On your Dashboard click on Details to open the schedule of your Event.


**Step 3:** To acknowledge a section or sub-section, click on **Acknowledge**.

When a section or sub-section is in **blue**, it means that some information must be entered or some conditions must be acknowledged for the section to be validated.

	For all issues relating to FEI Horse Passports/FEI Recognition Cards please contact your National Federation.All Horses competing at FEI Events must be registered with the FEI.FEI Passports or FEI Recognition Cards (for those Horses with a national passport approved by the FEI) are compulsory for FEI Events.NB: Horses entered in CIMs and in CSIP in their country of residence are not required to have an FEI Passport or FEI Recognition Cards but must be properly registered with the FEI and identifiable (GRS 137.2).Athletes who do not present a Horses Passport and/or Recognition Cards (for those Horses with a national justification of the FEI vents). The subject to Sanctions in accordance with Arnex Vi of the FEI vents Passport requirements will be subject to Sanctions in accordance with the Net National Passport present and/or set is provided to a Member State of the European Union: all Horses must have a national EU passport in compliance with EU Recognition card is applied. The exception to this being Horses in possession of an FEI passport which has been continually revaildated without interruption.
