How to connect an Hero microchip scanner to the FEI HorseApp

You have a Hero microchip scanner?

You will use the FEI HorseApp at your next Event to perform the Examination on Arrival?

Below you will find the step-by-step procedure to connect your scanner to the FEI HorseApp.

Step 1: Set the Hero scanner to Pair mode.



Step 2: Open Bluetooth on your mobile phone and search for devices.

Step 3: Press the scanner CSR HID Keyboard to connect.



Step 6: Click on the **thunderbolt** logo on the top right-hand side to connect the scanner with the FEI HorseApp.



Step 7: Locate the Hero scanner on the Keyboard Type scanner list and press **Enable**.

Step 8: Once the Hero scanner is connected to the FEI HorseApp, the button will turn **green** and the **thunderbolt** logo will also show that you are correctly connected.

Step 9: You can now proceed with scanning a Horse. To scan, place the microchip scanner on the Horse microchip and press the read button on the Hero scanner.


<u>Please note that a keyboard type scanner will work in a different way than</u> the other type of scanners.

For FEI Veterinarians only:

Step 1: Once connected you will need to press the "Scan Horse Microchip" button.

Step 2: A pop-up window will open. You can scan the microchip on the Horse and wait for the number to appear on the field.

Step 3: Press OK.
